### Triangle Peak Invests In Framehawk To Secure Corporate Data

Triangle Peak Partners has invested in corporate data security company Framehawk Inc., VentureWire has learned.

The firm joins Alsop Louie Partners and Correlation Ventures, which have provided Series A funding to the company, according to Framehawk's Web site.

Framehawk founder and Chief Executive Peter Badger confirmed the Triangle Peak investment but declined to discuss details until later in the year.

Framehawk has hired people who have worked at Oracle Corp., Nokia Corp., Lawrence Berkeley National Labs, NASA and major communications equipment vendors and global financial services firms.

The company's software enables users to access their companies' Web sites and applications from tablets, smart phones and other popular wireless devices without touching corporate data, which remains secured inside the corporate data center, the site says.

Framehawk says it's created a cloud-based software framework that "frames" applications or URLs so that users can interact with them "anywhere there is the barest minimum of a 3G wireless network connection" by clicking on an icon after they've downloaded a Framehawk application to their devices.

"Corporate auditors throw you a parade for stopping data leakage," the site says.

Framehawk customers can also brand the application themselves.
